

UK Sanctions on Russian-Origin Iron & Steel (Schedule 3B)

Effective: 30 September 2023

CILS International confirms full compliance with UK sanctions relating to iron and steel products of Russian origin, as outlined in the Russia (Sanctions (EU Exit) (Amendment) Regulations 2023.

Under this regulation, the UK prohibits the import of any iron or steel product listed in Schedule 3B that:

- Is listed in Part 2 or 3 of Schedule 3B of the Russia Regulations, and
- Has been altered, transformed, or processed in any third country, and
- Contains one or more Schedule 3B iron or steel products originally from Russia.

This applies to products under Chapters 72 and 73 of the UK Trade Tariff. The ban came into full effect on 30 September 2023 and applies regardless of any reprocessing outside Russia.

As a manufacturer of durable labels and associated equipment, we confirm that:

- No part or product supplied by CILS International contains iron or steel of Russian origin that has been processed in a third country.
- Our supply chain has been reviewed to ensure full traceability and conformity with the UK sanctions.
- Documentation such as supplier declarations and material certificates are retained as evidence of compliance.

CILS International is committed to responsible sourcing and full adherence to UK trade laws and international sanctions. We continuously monitor our supply chain to ensure ongoing compliance.
